





We utilise a combination of 1 to 1 and group work - mentoring and therapeutic support is provided as a 'wrap around service' to support the development of the young persons emotional literacy, behaviour management and coping mechanisms. This holistic approach has proven highly successful and effective at building strong relationships, facilitating individuals to get the help, opportunities and confidence they need to improve their life chances/outcomes.
